



## 1. Government Communication Network (GCN)

### **Project Description:**

In order to provide connectivity of the central administrations of the government with each other and its second units in provinces and to accelerate relevant affairs of administrations, monitoring of projects, plans and implementing the rehabilitation programs in the country, the MCIT has initiated the GCN project.

This project is mobilized with improved and modern technology that provides (fax telephone, internet, video conference) services. This project has been designed to ensure direct communication of governmental agencies with secondary units in the province and 34 provincial capitals and 42 governmental agencies and ministries have been covered. Worth mentioning, the above network has facilitated internet service delivery during first quarter of 2006 and improved the telecom revenue enhancement. This project is already completed in 2006.
